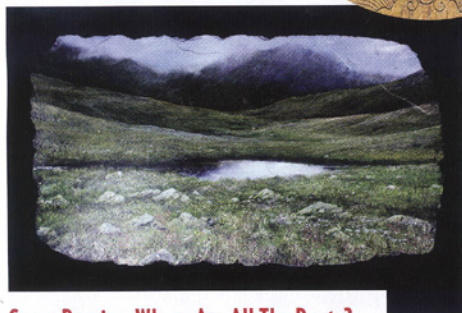
### Giorgio Casali: Photographer Domus
